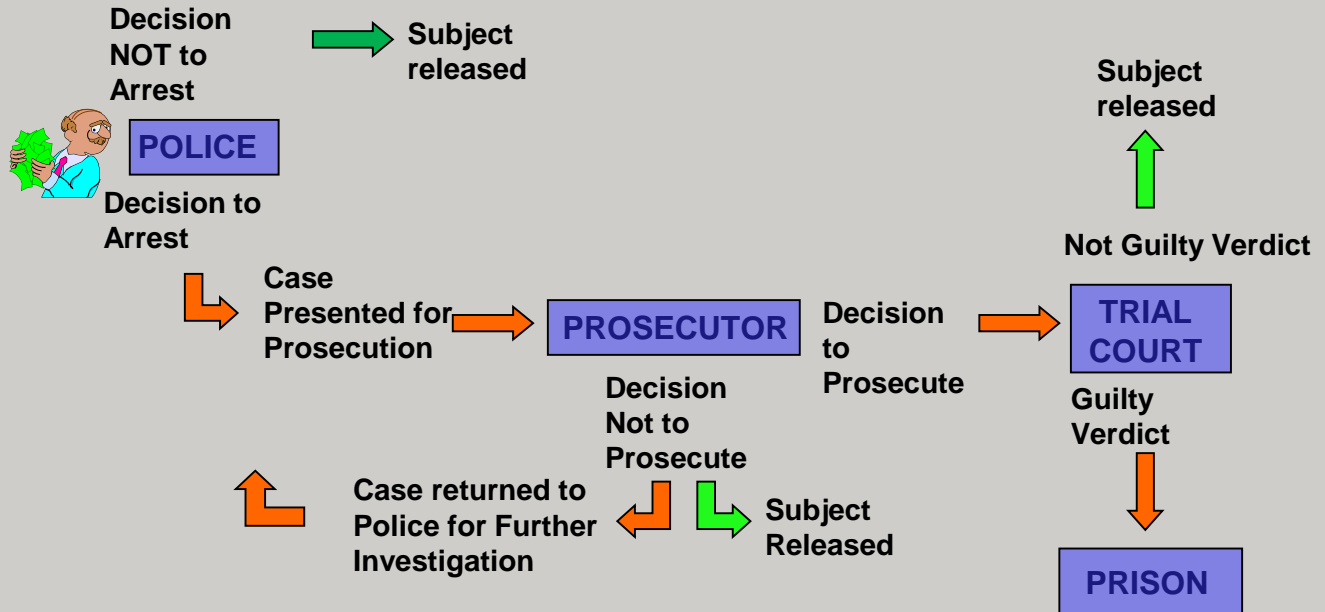

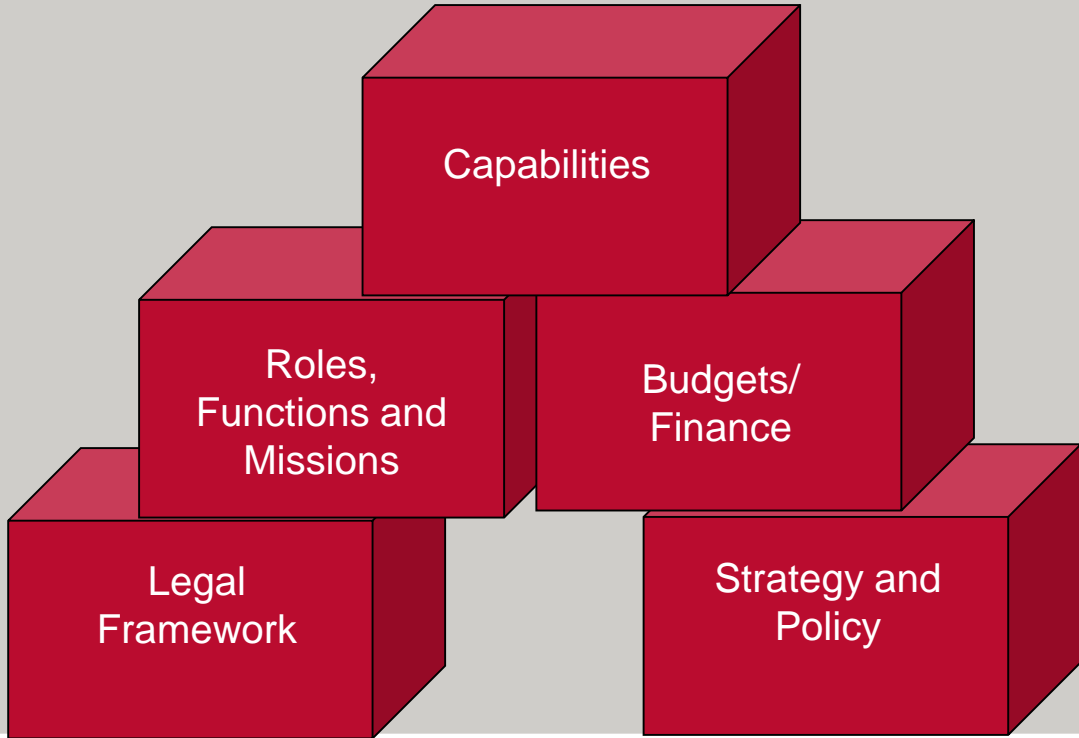
- Improve outcomes
